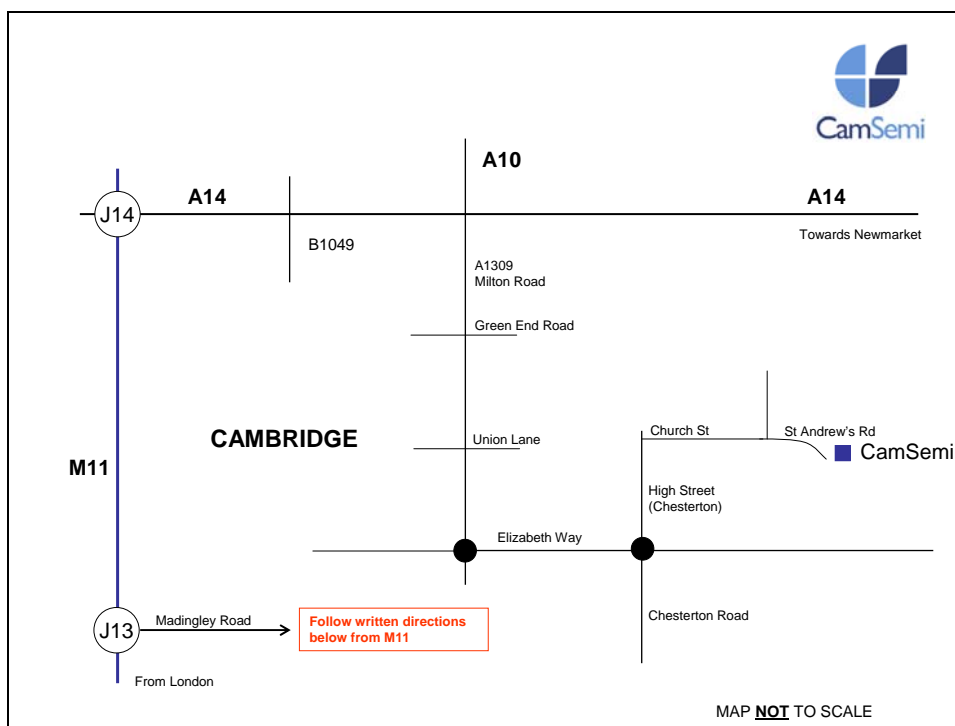


LOCATION MAP AND TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO CAMBRIDGE OFFICE

Please remember if you're coming by taxi then ask the driver to take you to St Andrew's Road (off Chesterton High Street) and NOT St Andrew's Street which is close to the railway station and right in the centre of Cambridge.

From Stansted Airport and the M11

- Stansted is at junction 8 of the M11, approximately 30 miles (50 km) south of Cambridge.
- From Stansted Airport follow the signs for the M11 to Cambridge.
- Leave the motorway at junction 13 and take the A1303 towards Cambridge.
- At the mini-roundabout, take the first exit into Northampton Street and continue ahead.
- At the large roundabout (with Staples in the middle), stay in the right-hand lane, past the zebra crossing and then move into the left-hand lane to continue along the A1303, Chesterton Road.
- Take the second exit at the next roundabout into High Street Chesterton, and then right into Church Street.
- Stay straight ahead and St Andrews House is on the left. You can park at the front of the building.

From Heathrow Airport - by car

- Heathrow Airport is about 80 miles (128 kms) from CamSemi's offices.
- Leave the airport complex to join the M25 (at junction 14), heading for the North and East and drive clockwise to junction 27.
- Exit the motorway at junction 27 to join the M11 North towards Cambridge.
- Leave the motorway at junction 13 taking the A1303 towards Cambridge.
- At the mini-roundabout, take the first exit into Northampton Street and continue ahead.
- At the large roundabout (with Staples in the middle), stay in the right-hand lane, past the zebra crossing and then move into the left-hand lane to continue along the A1303, Chesterton Road.
- Take the second exit at the next roundabout into High Street Chesterton, and then right into Church Street.
- Stay straight ahead and St Andrews House is on the left. You can park at the front of the building.

From Heathrow Airport - by rail

- Take the underground/tube service from Heathrow to King's Cross mainline train station. The Piccadilly Line from Heathrow goes directly to King's Cross.
- Trains then run regularly from King's Cross to Cambridge city centre. During the week a fast train takes typically around 50 minutes but off peak and at the weekend it can take around twice this time.

From the A14 (from either direction)

- Leave the A14 to join the A1309, Milton Road towards Cambridge.
- Continue straight ahead at the traffic light junction and at the first roundabout turn left.
- At the next roundabout, take the first exit into High Street Chesterton, and then right into Church Street.
- Stay straight ahead and St Andrews House is on the left.
